Whites

R Wines 'Pure Evil' **Chard**, Australia 7.27 /25

Roundest & food-friendliest. Forget your parents' lousy 'oak-bomb chard'. This new generation wine made from wonderfully sourced grapes creates a light, lively, creamy wine with notes of apple, pear & peach.

Terra Andina, **Sauvignon Blanc**, Chile

6.36/22

Brightest & most refreshing. A solid wine with fresh citrus notes of grapefruit & peach with a long, pleasing aftertaste.

Hofer, **Gruener Veltliner**, Austria 6.36/22

Most mineral crispness & multiple glass approachability. 'Gruvey', as insiders call it, is the most planted grape in Austria. It is crisp & dry with lime, mint & mineral flavors. Finishes with a lovely creamy sort of smoothness.

Rudolf Muller 'Shine' **Riesling**, Germany 7.5/30

Sweetest & most structured. Rudolf Muller uses new technologies to test the grapes he sources, ensuring that his traditional-style Mosel wines are of only the highest quality. This wine shines through with nice acidity to balance the sweet fruit & nice body on the palate.

Reds

Chateau Gigognan, **Cotes du Rhone**, France 8.18/30

Roundest & classiest. Classic Rhone varietals are sourced from neighboring country sides & bended by this highly regarded house of Chateneuf-du-Pape. Rich berry & bramble flavors show through. Excellent with cheeses!

Marquis Philips Roogle Red, **Shiraz/Cab**, AU

7.27/25

For Cabernet & red fruit lovers. Wonderfully structured with ripe fruit and dark spice from the Shiraz, backed with velvety tannins from the Cab.

Lancatay 'Huarpe' **Malbec**, Argentina 7.27/25

Biggest & darkest...do you like Zin? High altitude vines, with the help of French & American oak, produce a deep purple-red wine of big plum & cherry fruit, leathery spice, round & soft texture, & a lasting finish.

Protocolo, **Tempranillo**, Spain 5.45/20

Lightest & most quaffable. A Spanish wine made from their most famous grape. If the Spanish really get to drink a wine this good and take siestas on a regular basis, I'm moving.

Sparkling Wines

Segura Viudas Brut Reserva **Cava**, Spain 6.36/22

Created from grapes grown in the Penedea region of Spain, this is a fairly crisp Cava with floral notes and a rich flavor.

BEER

On Tap

DeKoninck 7.27

Hazy amber color with a smooth, medium body. Toasted malt flavors are followed by crispness, yeasty spice and sweet fruit. A truly quaffable Belgian beer.

Bell's Two-Hearted Ale 4.54

American IPA with floral hops, citrus, and sweet maltiness. A dangerously drinkable IPA with 7% Abv!

PBR 3.63

A classic lager established in Milwaukee, 1844.

Allagash White 5.00

One of the first & certainly the best American Belgian-style white ales. Unfiltered wheat beer pours cloudy blonde with notes of citrus & coriander.

Wells Bombardier 5.45

An English Ale with a rich creamy texture and copper color. A great balance of sweetness and bitterness.

Guinness 5.45

The classic, satisfying Irish stout (and fewer calories than most light beer...who would have guessed?).

DuFraín 5.91

Guinness malts are transformed with the addition of one of our espresso shots.

Ruby Red 8.18

Slightly tart, mostly sweet...fresh grapefruit juice with Ruby Red Vodka.

White Chocolate Kiss 8.18

Chocolatey creamy goodness. House-infused Vanilla Vodka & Godiva White Chocolate Liqueur, lined with chocolate.

Coffee Drinks

Martin Blanco 7.27

House-infused Vanilla Vodka, Coffee Liqueur, Amaretto, and Tryst Espresso, topped with milk and served over ice.

Rude Boy 5.45

A staff favorite. A shot of Tryst Espresso in a shot of Baileys

Voodoo Lady 7.27

A favorite of regular customers, Hendrix and Ween. Bacardi Dark Rum and Coffee Liqueur in our hot Vanilla Chai

Tryst Toddy 8.18

Bourbon served with cinnamon, nutmeg, lemon, honey, and a pot of Earl Grey tea

Irish Latte 7.27

Irish Cream liqueur steamed with hot milk, 2 shots of Tryst espresso, and Irish Whiskey to top it all off.

Specialty Drinks

DC Iced Tea 8.18

Like DC, as tough as Long Island, only classier. Made with Absolut, Tanqueray, Bacardi & Cuervo.

John Daly 7.27

Tea off with...Reyka Icelandic Vodka and a touch of Peach Schnapps, topped with whole leaf fruit-infused black iced tea and lemonade

Joy Juice 8.18

Citrus Vodka, Raspberry Liqueur, Triple Sec, with fresh lime and orange juice

Dark and Stormy 7.27

Goslings Gold Rum muddled with fresh ginger and topped with ginger ale

Basil-Oshka 8.18

Josh's dangerously tasty concoction of Icelandic Vodka with muddled fresh basil, grapes & lime.

Work Horse's Neck 7.27

Our over-worked staff loves Jim Bean and ginger ale, served tall with house-made Sassafras bitters.

Sepisoda 8.18

A refreshing elixir created by our Mother-of-Invention; fresh mint & cucumbers combined with vodka, lemon syrup & soda.

Adam's Morgan Sunset 7.27

Gold Tequila mixed with fresh lime and orange juice, tinted with raspberry liqueur.

Kato 8.18

A classy creation combining muddled grapes, house-infused green tea vodka, Chartreuse, Riesling & Champagne

Weak at the Bee's Knees 7.27

An aromatic twist on a sweet and citrusy, classic gin cocktail (we use 209 Gin & Elderflower Liqueur).

Champagne Fizz 7.27

A fruity, bubbly delight of Stoli Razz, Stoli Orange, and Poma Liqueur, topped with Champagne

Oaxacan Mud Bath 7.27

Mezcal, house-infused with mole spices, blended with silver tequila. Served on the rocks and garnished with a twist.

Single Malt Scotch

Lagavulin 16 yr

One of the oldest distilleries in Scotland. An Islay with a powerful peat and smoke aroma, full body, and a slight sweetness.

Oban 14 yr

Distilled in the west Highlands, having a medium body that is smooth and easy to drink. Starting sweet, then becoming smoky with a spicy finish.

Glenlivet 12 yr

The clean spring water of the Glen of Livet gives this Speyside a delicate, flowery aroma and a light to medium body with a balanced sweet and malty finish. The most widely sold single malt scotch in the U.S.A.

Talisker 10 yr

Distilled on the Isle of Skye, known for its above average peat content. It has an intense peat aroma, and a full body with sweet and salty notes and a peppery finish.

Laphroig 10 yr

Produced on the west coast of Scotland using peat only found on the Isle of Islay. The drying of the malted barley over a peat fire gives its characteristic rich flavor and aroma. An “acquired taste,” even by whiskey drinkers, it has strong peaty overtones with a warm and dry finish.
